



Employees seen per therapist

This is quick guide to give the maximum number of clients that can be seen within a half day and full day session, depending on the number of therapists on site.

We can of course adapt our time on site and/or number of therapists to suit the exact number of employees wishing to receive our massage therapies.

A half day is based on 3¼ hours of massage sessions.
A full day is based on 6½ hours of massage sessions.

'Take a Break' – At Your Desk Massages

For 10-minute therapies:

<i>Number of massage therapists</i>	<i>Clients per half day</i>	<i>Clients per full day</i>
1	15	28
2	30	56
3	45	84

*A total of 10 minutes per hour will be allocated for movement between employees

'Sit Back and Relax' – Seated Massage

Each therapist will require a separate room for therapies to take place.

For 15-minute therapies:

<i>Number of massage therapists</i>	<i>Clients per half day</i>	<i>Clients per full day</i>
1	10	18
2	20	36
3	30	72

For 20-minute therapies:

<i>Number of massage therapists</i>	<i>Clients per half day</i>	<i>Clients per full day</i>
1	7	14
2	14	28
3	21	56
